



CATERING ASSISTANCE GRANTS FOR LOCAL COMMUNITY EVENTS

Local community organisations make an important contribution in Redfern and Waterloo. Small one-off catering assistance grants of up to \$200 are available to help non-profit community groups based in Redfern and Waterloo meet the cost of holding a community event.

The grants are being provided by the Redfern Waterloo Authority in partnership with the NSW Community Relations Commission.

As funds are limited, preference will be given to smaller community events which benefit a local neighbourhood and the wider local community by:

- encouraging interaction between residents - particularly between people from culturally diverse backgrounds,
- encouraging participation in local community and cultural activities which build a sense of community,
- bringing residents together to discuss solutions to local needs.
- strengthening existing community networks,
- improving awareness and use of community and cultural services and resources.

A neighbourhood BBQ or a small-scale community cultural festival are two examples of events which would be eligible for funding grants.

Conditions:

- The Community Relations Commission and the Redfern-Waterloo Authority must be acknowledged in all documentation associated with the event/function. This includes correct utilisation of the CRC logo and the RWA logo.
- Acquittal of the funds against the funding criteria and report back on the event must be provided within 12 weeks of holding the event.
- In the case of any changes to times, dates, objectives or type of function, the Redfern-Waterloo Authority must be advised prior to the changes being implemented.
